

The Regie's business is committed to the highest professional standards on the level of agriculture, industry, commerce, and finance, relying on modern e-management solutions, and keeping in mind the development of the society, agriculture, and farmers.

AGRICULTURE

We are the exclusive authority that grants plantation licenses to tobacco farmers, provides agricultural guidance, supervises plantation techniques and methods, oversees planted areas and ensures overall quality and development through a variety of mechanisms. Once the crop has matured, Regie oversees the harvesting, drying and packaging process prior to delivery to the organization's plants, where the tobacco and tunbac is sorted, packed, prepared and stored before it is processed or exported.

PRODUCTION

We produce local brands of cigarettes and flavored tobacco at our facilities that are equipped with automatic, fast and efficient lines of production. The Regie produces seven local brands and an international one.

TRADE

We are the exclusive agent for all imported tobacco products and the sole agency that has the authority to grant permits for the sale of tobacco.






PILLARS OF THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT: FACTS AND FIGURES

SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE

160 Guidance Seminars for farmers in **90 villages** across the North, the South and the Bekaa for a cost of LBP **120 million**.

More than **400 annual field visits** to tobacco farmers by **72 correspondents and experts**.

LBP **60 billion** invested annually in tobacco crop purchase; LBP **600 million** in agriculture equipment and LBP **730 million** in pesticides, seeds and fertilizers distributed to farmers.

Tobacco leaf crop purchased from **25000 farmers** across the North, South and Bekaa in more than **457 villages**.

Over **8.5 million Kg**. of tobacco leaf purchased in 2015 from Lebanese farmers for an amount of LBP **93 billion**.

Around LBP **1.5 billion** invested to support **42 development projects** in cooperation with **40 municipalities** of tobacco growing towns in the North, the Bekaa and the South.

LBP **460 million** invested in **300 scholarships** and vital projects for the tobacco farmers children in collaboration with tobacco companies.











PRODUCTION

Production of 7 local brands and a foreign one (Allure)

5 factories in **4 Lebanese cities** in addition to **7 main facilities** and **2 centres** of Agriculture research and testing.

85% enhancement of purity of water in Regie as a result of the instalment of a water purification station.

Around **223000 boxes** of Cedars cigarettes locally produced in 2015.

LBP **32 billion** spent on the rehabilitation of Bikfaya and Ghazieh factories and the cigarette factory in Hadath.

1159 brands of tobacco products (Tobacco, tunbac, cigars and cigarillos) imported from more than 70 foreign companies and distributed to more than 700 heads of sales across Lebanon.

The Regie deals with more than $1340\ suppliers$.

COMMUNITY AND ECONOMY


Around LBP **350 billion** paid each year to the Lebanese Government in taxes.

Around **1000 fixed-income jobs** offered to the Lebanese citizens across the country.

Over LBP **500 billion** paid each year to employees in wages and social benefits.

Training for **1000 participant**s during 2015 in **71 sessions** by virtue of a training agreement concluded with the Institut des Finances.

Over LBP **13 billion** in donations to national institutions (Commandment of the Army, General Directorate of General Security and Bassel Fleihan Financial and Economic Institute).









COMMERCE AND TRADE

More than LBP **855 billion** of local and imported products sold in 2015.

Over LBP **731 billion** of total revenues in 2015.

More than LBP **2 billion invested** in fighting tobacco trafficking in 2015 (reducing it from 40% to 25%) and LBP **15 billion** in fines collection.






